ROME CHAMBER MUSC FESTIVAL SEASON 2015

Daniela Porro, director of Lazio Regional Secretariat, gladly presents the twelfth season of the Rome Chamber Music Festival by Robert McDuffie, which is one of Rome's most anticipated cultural events of June. The event will take place in the wonderful scenario of the Galleria Nazionale di Arte Antica di Palazzo Barberini, directed by Cinzia Ammannato, from June 4th, when the opened concert rehearsal will start in the Hall Pietro da Cortona. 34 artists from all over the world, whereof 15 international coach and 19 young artists, selected and invited thanks to the Missione Giovani, its partners and its sponsors, will play under the painted vault.

The principal dancers of the Hamburg Ballet, Silvia Azzoni e Oleksander Ryabko, partnerr also in life, will be the guests of honor, dancing two choreographies expressly made for the festival. This will be the first time that such important dancers will dance in the Hall Pietro da Cortona. The night concerts will start on June 7th (invitation soiree) and will continue every night until June 11th. Among the worldwide known artists, guests of the Rome Chamber Music Festival, there are Lawrence Dutton, Alessandro Carbonare, Francesco Bossone, Elena Matteucci, Guglielmo Pellarin, Guido Corti, Kurt Muroki, as well as Robert McDuffie, founder and artistic director.

These artists together will lay some of the most famous masterpieces of the chamber music, both classic and contemporary: from Beethoven to Brahms passing through Schubert, Adams, Glass, Pärt and Martucci. On June 11th the festival will finish with some of the most famous cinema music, with the arrangement of the soundtracks composer **David Mallamud**.

The *Festival* wants to nourish the new musicians generations, offering them a great opportunity of growth both personal and artistic, as well as professional. As McDuffie précises, “I want to offer to the young musicians the instruments to become great entrepreneurs of themselves. Furthermore, during the Festival we will have many opened concert rehearsals and master classes.”
